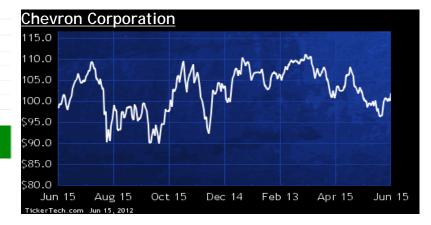

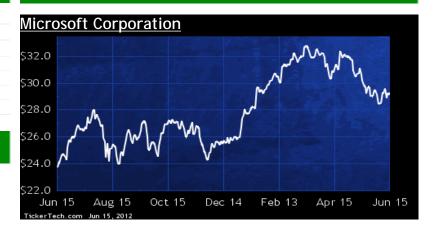

#### T Dividend History



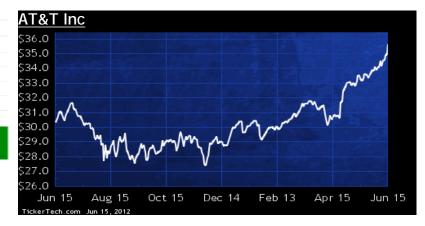
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# INTC - 3.1% Yield

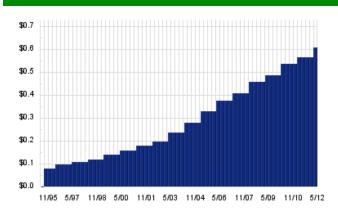

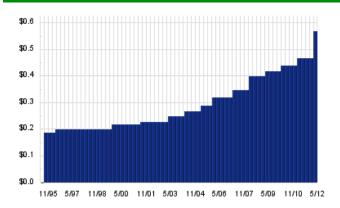

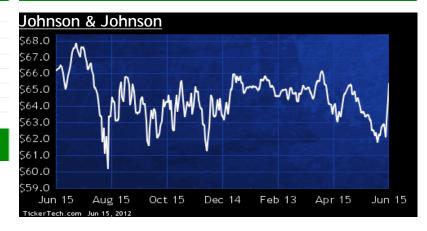

#### XOM Dividend History



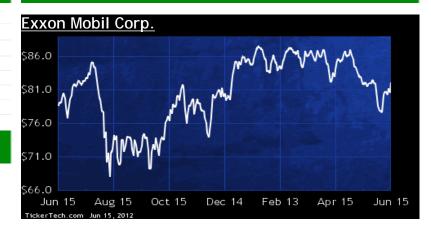
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#### JNJ - 3.7% Yield



Johnson & Johnson is a holding company. Through its subsidiaries, Co. is engaged in the research and development, manufacture and sale of a range of products in the health care field. Co. has three business segments: Consumer, which includes a range of products used in the baby care, skin care, oral care, wound care, and women's health fields among others; Pharmaceutical, which includes products in areas such as anti-infective, antipsychotic, contraceptive, dermatology, hematology, immunology, and neurology among others; and Medical Devices and Diagnostics, which includes a range of products distributed to wholesalers, hospitals and retailers.

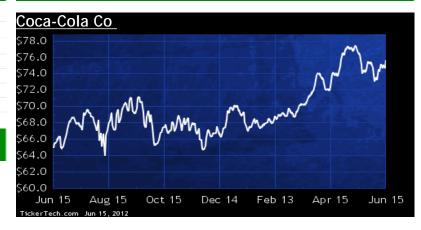

#### PG Dividend History



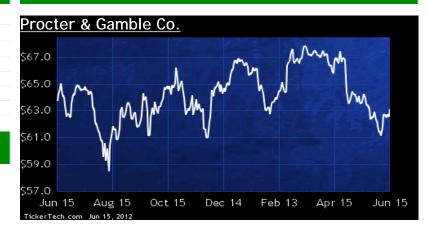

Wal-Mart Stores operates retail stores in a range of formats. Co.'s operations comprise three business segments: Walmart U.S., which operates retail stores in different formats in the U.S. under the Walmart or Wal-Mart brand, as well as Walmart's online retail operations, walmart.com; Walmart International, which consists of its retail operations in 26 countries, and includes numerous formats of retail stores, restaurants, Sam's Clubs and online retail operations that operate outside the U.S.; and Sam's Club, which includes the warehouse membership clubs in the U.S., as well as samsclub.com. As of Jan 31 2012, Co. had a total of 4,479 domestic stores and 5,651 international stores.

#### PG - 3.6% Yield



Procter & Gamble is engaged in providing branded consumer goods products. Co.'s products are sold in more than 180 countries primarily through mass merchandisers, grocery stores, membership club stores, drug stores and high-frequency stores, the neighborhood stores which serve many consumers in developing markets. Co. has on-the-ground operations in approximately 80 countries. As of June 30 2011, Co. was organized into two Global Business Units (GBU's): Beauty and Grooming and Household Care. The business units comprising the GBUs are aggregated into six reportable segments: Beauty; Grooming; Health Care; Snacks and Pet Care; Fabric Care and Home Care; and Baby Care and Family Care.





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
